

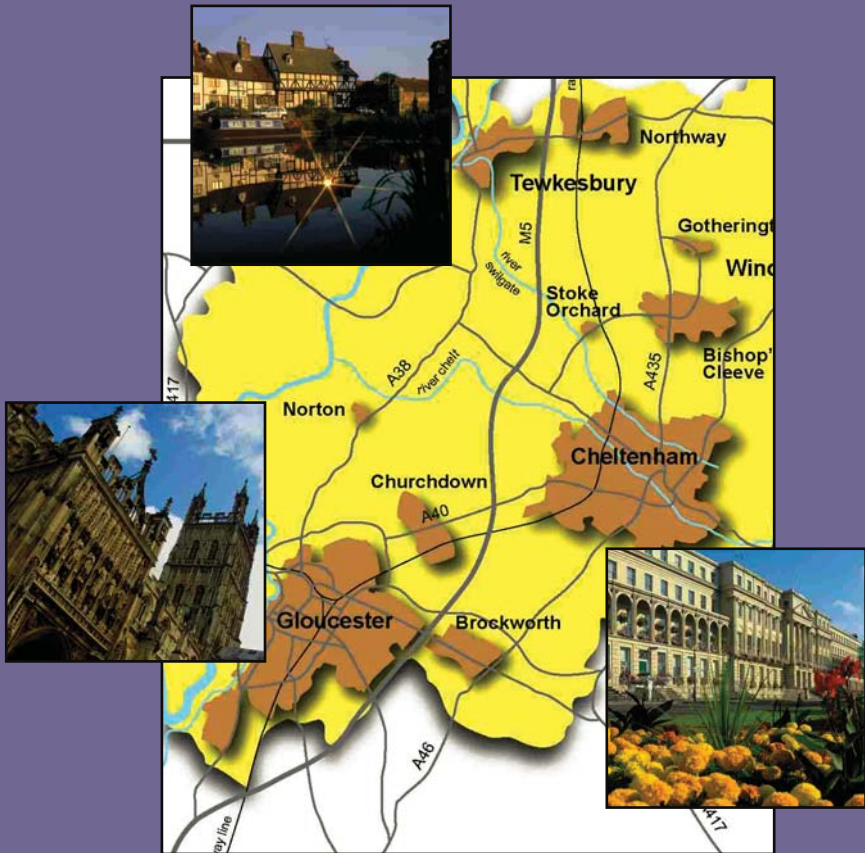

What is the Joint Core Strategy?

The Joint Core Strategy (JCS) is a high-level planning document that will shape the way the areas of Gloucester, Cheltenham and Tewkesbury develop in the period up to 2026. It covers the administrative areas of Gloucester City, and Cheltenham and Tewkesbury Boroughs.

Why are we producing the Joint Core Strategy?

Working jointly means that new development in the JCS area can be properly co-ordinated across the three authorities. It also means that the two main urban areas of Gloucester and Cheltenham can be planned so they act as a single sub-regional centre to attract investment and jobs. This will bring benefits to the urban and rural areas.

Consultation - we need your comments!

The Issues and Questions Consultation Document has been published to raise awareness of the key issues that the JCS area faces and to generate debate about how they could be addressed. This is the first stage in the process, with more detailed options being worked up and consulted on at a later date.

Preparing the JCS means making choices about how the area will develop in the future. It is important that local communities have input. We want your comments on:

- Key issues we need to address
- Our vision for the area in 2026
- Topics that should be covered
- Policies that should be included and priorities
